Terms of Reference of the Technical Committee:-

- The Technical Committee shall review the Brief Document on Sukhna Wetland prepared by Forest Department, Chandigarh.
- The Technical Committee shall submit its recommendations keeping Wetlands (Conservation & Management) Rules, 2017 notified by Govt. of India dated 26.9.2017 in mind and shall clearly list out activities to be prohibited or to be regulated for Sukhna Wetland and its Zone of Influence separately.
- For activities inside Zone of Influence, the consultation with States of Punjab and Haryana shall be done.
- The Committee shall submit its recommendations within one month of its constitution.
